#### **Holy Communion**

In the Bible, the Apostle Paul wrote: Let a person examine himself and so eat of the bread, and drink of the cup (1 Cor. 11:28). Before attending the Lord's Supper, ask yourself the following questions

- Do I believe that I am sinner, and am sorry for my sins? (Prov. 28:13; Rom. 3:23; I John 1:8-9)
- Do I believe that Jesus Christ by his death, offers me forgiveness for all my sins? (Rom. 5:8; Col. 2:13; Heb. 9:28; 1 John 1:7)
- Do I believe that I receive the body and blood of Christ in and with the bread and wine (not merely symbolically present)? (Mat. 26:26-28; 1 Cor. 10:16; 1 Cor. 11:24-25)
- Do I desire to turn from my sinful ways and live a God pleasing life by the power of the Holy Spirit? (Is. 1:16; John 8:11; Rom. 6:12)

If you are unable to answer yes to these questions, please talk to the pastor or an elder before communing, as participating without a proper understanding of Holy Communion can be spiritually harmful (1 Cor. 11:27-29).

If you can answer yes to these questions, then come with a repentant heart and join us in the reception of the Lord's Supper. Adults and children not yet instructed about Holy Communion are invited to come forward to receive a blessing.

#### Voice of the Martyrs

Read about Alice, whose husband was killed in Nigeria in 2011 by Militant Fulani Muslims. She found it difficult to provide for her four children, but continued to farm their plot of land. A year and a half later, they struck again and burned her home to the ground and she was forced to flee her village. Over time she found a way to earn a meager living, support her family while still faithfully tithing. In 2011, the Fulani Muslims burned her fields. She continued to scrape by for two more years until she met some VOM workers, who helped her with her living expenses and got her relocated to a simple home.

Today Alice and her children are thriving thanks to the help received from the global body of Christ. Alice's faith continues to grow as she has seen God work in her life since her husbands death: She has even forgiven the men who killed her husband. When she saw a neighbor who killed her husband, Alice



summoned the courage to approach The **Voice** him and greet him kindly. This act of Martyrs love has helped her find peace.

#### **LINC Ministries**

Do you know your God-given calling?

Summer is here and there is a lot of "newness" in the air around LINC. New team members, new LINC cities, a new program and a new newsletter for the nation-wide LINC Network,

As part of our ongoing internal renovation project (more to share on that in the months to come) we want to be a blessing to you in every way that we can, including through the occasional email.

For today, here is some food for thought: I recently wrote an article titled, "Does the American Church need a new Strategy?" In it I contend that the church doesn't need a new strategy, it needs to remember the original strategy with a modern expression.

What do I mean by that? Worship services are great at reaching Christians who are looking for places to worship, but they are not God's given strategy for reaching new people. You are.

Jesus didn't command the organization to go and make new disciples, He gave that mandate to His disciples and to us. So how do we do that?

One of Jesus' mandates to His followers is to "love thy neighbor". Christians in the first 300 years after Jesus' resurrection were known for just that, amazing acts of sacrificial love. At a time when Christians were severely persecuted Aristidis gave a report to Caesar regarding the Christian movement. Here are some highlights from the report:

- 1. They fast for days in order to provide food for the needy
- 2. When they see a stranger in need they take them into their homes
- 3. Those with more give to those with less, without boasting
- 4. They care for widows and orphans with kindness
- 5. There is something divine in the midst of them

I wonder, what would they say about us today?

Whether as a grassroots missionary (LINC leader), financial partner or a friend of LINC, you are an important part of God's mission to your community. It is our collective calling to love our neighbors in Jesus' name. How it plays out in each of our lives is as unique as we are.

How can we help you clarify and live out your God-given calling? Peace, friend!
